[Federal Direct Stafford \(Subsidized and Unsubsidized\) Loans](#) are funding available to eligible students upon the completion of their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This funding differs from grant/scholarship funding as it **must be paid back** to the Department of Education once the student has graduated, leaves school, or drops below half-time enrollment.

Starting in 2026-2027, loan amounts will differ depending on a student's dependency status, their level in college, their primary program of study, and their credit hour enrollment per term. Loans are now subject to a Schedule of Reduction, meaning that students who are enrolled in less than full-time (12+ credits) enrollment status will have reduced loan eligibility. Changes to enrollment status may impact future disbursement amounts and eligibility.
