The duration of a student's eligibility to receive a Federal Pell Grant is the equivalent of six (6) years of funding. The maximum amount of Pell Grant funding a student can receive *each year* is equal to 100% (Fall/Spring). The 6-year equivalent is 600%. Once you have received the Federal Pell Grant for 600%, you will no longer be eligible for the Federal Pell Grant for future semesters.

Based on information reported to the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) by the schools you have attended, you may have received a total amount of Pell Grant that EQUALS or EXCEEDS the cumulative total you are eligible to receive.
